This **first Sunday in Advent**, just like every year, we light our first candle. We call it the candle of Hope, and in the past, we've always concentrated on what we hope for. But this year, perhaps we can concentrate on what it means to light a candle, any candle. We do it every week, using it as a metaphor for Jesus who explained things that were otherwise hidden to us. But that light only illuminates something that is already there. If we admire the vibrant colours of a forest in the fall or the shimmering hill slopes covered in the white of winter, all that beauty is there whether it is light or not. We can't see them at night, but they're still there. In a similar way, the glories that the light of God demonstrates are already in existence. And it seems to me that this is of incredible importance for us. If there is goodness within the human psyche (and I believe there is) then that goodness is built into the very core of our being. It is already implanted there, and the light of God causes it to grow and flourish. And so, I'd suggest, that lighting this candle is the best reason of all for us to have hope this Advent Season.
